





The Admission committee formulates the admission policy in accordance with the rules laid down by the System. To apply for admission, the student should have passed the Last Class/Grade. Students waiting for the results will also be entertained. Such students, if selected in admission process, will be granted provisional admissions. These admissions will automatically stand cancelled if such candidates fail to attain the required criteria.

The admission will be given purely on merit.

Students securing top positions in SSC / Matric will be awarded 100% scholarship.

Admission Test will be mandatory for all.

Registration will open for class XI from 1st March

Minimum age limits

Specific age is not defined, however age should commensurate with the Class in which admission is sought.

List of documents to be submitted along with the application form:

- Character Certificate from the head of institution last attended (for college only)
- Marks certificate (Original).
 - 12 Recent passport size photographs of the student.
- Photo copy of CNIC of Parents/ Guardian.
- A student coming from the Board other than Hyderabad Board must submit migration contificate and eligibility certificate.
- The student seeking admission in class XII must submit T.C and permission letter From B.I.S.E Hyderabad.

Note: If computer taken in IX class, will have to take (P.E) or Submit IX Bio pass Certificate of IX Class from B.I.S.E. For admission in (P.M).

System Rules

1. Discipline

- All students must bring all the required books and notebooks as per time table daily.
- Change of classrooms between periods if required should be done in silence.
- Shouting or whistling / use of foul or improper language is not allowed in the campus premises.
- To throw anything at any one is strictly forbidden.
- Water fights are not allowed.
- Students should not damage or disfigure school/college property. It is forbidden to write or draw graffiti on the walls/ desks.
- Damages done even by accident should be reported at once to the class teacher or to the Principal. Any damage done will be made good by the one who causes it.
- Students should not be late for assembly. They may be fined or sent home if they come late as a habit.
 Students must attend all functions held in the campus.
- Students should be neatly dressed in school uniform.
- They must posses all the books & note books required for that day.
- Students should bring their diaries daily.
 Students should not bring following.
 - i. Sharp instruments
 - Costly material like ornaments, watches, pens etc.
 - iii. Mobiles/Cameras & other electronic gadgetries
 - iv. Chalia or Paan Supari.

2. Regularity

- It is advised that students do not stay away from campus unless there is an emergency.
- Assessment tests must never be missed. Habitual absentees will be awarded a zero.
- Students' attendance in all campus functions is mandatory.
- Bunking or playing truant is strictly forbidden.

3. Personal Hygiene & Uniform

- All students must come to campus in proper clean uniform daily.
- Nails must be clean and trimmed.
- Boys should get their hair cut at least once a month.
- Students who are untidily / shabbily dressed or not in proper uniform might be fined / asked to return home.
- No undesired books (other than text books or library books), or magazines should be brought to campus.
- Lending or borrowing of money and other articles is not permitted.
- The Management is not responsible for the goods lost. It is advisable not to bring valuable articles like expensive watches, fountain pens and mobile phones to campus.
- Bullying and use of foul / improper language are punishable offences.
- The Management reserves the right to suspend / rusticate or to take strict disciplinary action against a student whose diligence or progress in studies is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
- Parents and guardians may not visit their wards or teacher in the classroom without permission of the Principal.
- A Student who uses unfair means during a test will be awarded a zero in the subject and a warning letter will be sent to the parents.
- No student will be allowed to go home during study hours without permission from the concerned Authorities.

A note of explanation is required if a student misses school/college for any reason.

- A student returning to school/college after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease, should produce a doctor's certificate permitting him/her to do so.
